1	rhetorical	adj. of; having the nature of; or according to rhetoric using or characterized by mere rhetoric; or artificial eloquence; showy and elaborate in style "Rhetorical precision is a dying art in modern politics."
2	anachronistic	adj. anything that is or seems to be out of its proper time in history "His views were seen as charmingly anachronistic."
4	decadence	n. 1 a decline into immorality; loss of moral values; 2 the act or process or condition of decline into an inferior state "Western decadence is a theme often overlooked."
5	rectitude	n. high moral character "A sense of moral rectitude is essential for leadership."
