4	vouchsafe	v. 1 to grant or furnish often in a gracious or condescending manner; to give by way of reply 2 to grant as a privilege or special favor "If the honorable member would vouchsafe an answer."
5	tergiversation	n. 1 falsification by means of vague or ambiguous language; 2 the act of abandoning a party or cause "The government is guilty of endless tergiversation."
