1	epiphany	n. a sudden and clear idea or understanding about something. "The epiphany came not with a bang, but in quiet."
2	reminiscence	n. 1 the act of remembering or recollecting past experiences 2 a mental impression retained and recalled from the past "The book is a long, painful reminiscence."
3	nostalgia	n. a longing for something past "Nostalgia can be a dangerous political weapon."
4	restraint	n. a restraining or being restrained a restraining influence or action a means or instrument of restraining a loss or limitation of liberty; confinement control of emotions; impulses; etc; reserve; constraint "The power of the prose lies in its restraint."
5	philosophical	adj. 1 of or relating to philosophy or philosophers; 2 characterized by the attitude of a philosopher; meeting trouble with levelheaded detachment "His novels are essentially philosophical inquiries."
