1	mellifluous	adj. sweetly flowing; pleasant to the ear "The mellifluous tones of the English language are a joy to inhabit."
2	phantasmagoria	n. an early type of magiclantern show consisting of various optical illusions in which objects rapidly change size; blend into one another; etc. a rapidly changing series of things seen or imagined; as the figures or events of a dream any rapidly c "A phantasmagoria of light and sound that dazzles the senses."
3	susurrus	n. a soft murmuring or rustling sound "Language is a susurrus of the soul."
4	ebullient	adj. overflowing with fervor or enthusiasm or excitement "He was an ebullient host, brimming with infectious enthusiasm."
5	arcane	adj. of a secret or esoteric nature; mysterious "His interests remained stubbornly arcane."
