#	Word	Definition / Example
1	labyrinthine	adj. 1 resembling a complex system of paths or tunnels in which it is easy to get lost; 2 complicated; tortuous "His labyrinthine verses reward repeated listening — each pass through the architecture revealing previously invisible structural connections."
2	kaleidoscopic	having changing patterns or colors that are bright and varied "Kaleidoscopic imagery fragments and reassembles mundane experience into patterns whose strangeness illuminates rather than obscures underlying emotional truth."
3	onomatopoeic	a word that imitates the sound it describes "His onomatopoeic sensitivity to sound transforms syllables into percussive events as rhythmically precise as the instrumental bed beneath them."
4	associative	adj. 1 pertaining to an operation in which the result is the same regardless of the way the elements are grouped; 2 causing union or bringing together "Associative leaps between seemingly unconnected images generate the vertiginous density that distinguishes his lyrical architecture from conventional verse."
5	subterranean	adj. 1 lying beneath the earth's surface; 2 secret or hidden "Subterranean anxieties about creative purpose and social belonging surface obliquely through imagery too compressed for straightforward autobiographical reading."
6	taxonomic	adj. relating to the science of classification, especially in biology, concerning the arrangement of organisms into groups based on similarities and differences. "His taxonomic cataloguing of urban detritus — objects, textures, forgotten things — elevates inventory into a form of melancholic social documentation."
7	neologistic	relating to newly created words or expressions "Neologistic invention in his lyrics creates private vocabularies that reward the initiated listener without entirely excluding the merely curious."
8	cryptographic	relating to the art of writing or solving codes "Cryptographic density in his verses operates as both aesthetic commitment and philosophical statement about meaning's resistance to easy extraction."
9	synaptic	adj. of or relating to the junction between two neurons or between a neuron and a muscle "The synaptic velocity of his rhyme schemes enacts cognitively the overstimulated urban consciousness his lyrics simultaneously describe and embody."
10	introspective	adj. inclined to look inward and examine ones thoughts and feelings. "Introspective excavation of creative doubt and social alienation proceeds through metaphor so oblique that confession becomes indistinguishable from mythology."
11	alliterative	adj. having the same consonant at the beginning of each stressed syllable "Alliterative clustering of consonants creates sonic architecture that carries independent pleasure entirely apart from the semantic content it delivers."
12	vernacular	n. the language of one's country "His vernacular draws equally from street idiom, scientific nomenclature, and invented compound words, fusing registers that convention keeps rigorously separated."
13	compulsive	adj. of; having to do with; or resulting from compulsion "A compulsive cataloguing of overlooked phenomena — insects, rust, peripheral figures — generates a poetics of

14	idiosyncratic	adj. an odd or peculiar habit "His idiosyncratic worldview is so fully realized that entering it requires temporarily surrendering the expectation of linear interpretive handholds."
15	palimpsestic	relating to something that has been reused or altered but still bears traces of its earlier form "Palimpsestic layers of reference accumulate across albums, each new work recontextualizing earlier imagery in ways that reward the longitudinal listener."
