#	Word	Definition / Example
1	naturalistic	relating to a style that represents things as they are in nature "Her naturalistic vision refuses the consolation of redemption — characters are shaped by forces larger and older than individual will."
2	compulsive	adj. of; having to do with; or resulting from compulsion "Compulsive interiority drives her narratives forward — consciousness unable to rest, perpetually excavating its own most disturbing preoccupations."
3	transgenerational	something that affects multiple generations of a family or group "Transgenerational trauma in her family sagas passes from body to body like a biological inheritance no act of will can interrupt."
4	visceral	adj. stemming from instinct or intuition rather than the intellect. "Her visceral prose inhabits physical sensation so completely that reading becomes an uncomfortably embodied rather than merely intellectual experience."
5	gothicism	a style of art and literature that emphasizes dark and mysterious themes "American Gothicism in her work is not regional atmosphere but a diagnostic instrument revealing the violence beneath national mythology."
6	fecundity	the ability to produce a lot of new growth or ideas "Her creative fecundity — novels, stories, essays, poetry — suggests a consciousness for which not writing would be the genuine aberration."
7	predatory	adj. living by killing and eating other animals "Predatory power dynamics between men and women are rendered in her fiction with an unflinching anatomical precision."
8	obsessive	adj. characterized by that which preoccupies one's mind or emotions excessively or abnormally "Obsessive psychological states are her natural fictional territory — minds that cannot release what reason insists they must relinquish."
9	socioeconomic	relating to the interaction of social and economic factors "Socioeconomic determinism shapes her working-class characters without reducing them — circumstance constrains without entirely extinguishing agency."
10	protean	adj. taking on different forms "Her protean stylistic range — from domestic realism to gothic horror to experimental fiction — defies every attempt at simple categorization."
11	relentless	adj. not relenting; harsh; pitiless persistent; unremitting "The relentless forward pressure of her prose enacts the psychological desperation of characters who cannot pause without confronting themselves."
12	claustrophilia	a love or strong preference for small, enclosed spaces "A kind of claustrophilia governs her fictional spaces — enclosed communities generating intensities impossible in more open arrangements."
13	mythologizing	to create stories or legends about someone or something, often making them seem greater than they are "Her mythologizing of American violence transforms specific incidents into something approaching national ritual and collective confession."

14	unflinching	adj. not shrinking from danger “Unflinching psychological portraiture of perpetrators as well as victims distinguishes her moral seriousness from mere sensationalism.”
15	introspection	n. observation or examination of one's own mental and emotional state mental processes “Her stories often delve into the depths of human introspection, revealing hidden layers of emotion.”
