

interlocutory *(in-ter-loc-u-to-ry)*

Definition

adj. 1 consisting of dialogue; 2 law pronounced during the course of an action as a decision; not finally decisive of a case

Example Sentence

He used an **interlocutory** teaching method. OR He issued an **interlocutory** decree.

silence; final
