Definition

v. to satisfy completely as a hunger or desire from Latin root 'satis' meaning ENOUGH

Example Sentence

The host tried to **satiate** his guests at dinner.

Synonyms

stuff; satisfy; completely or excessively

Antonyms

deprive; dissatisfy; leave wanting
